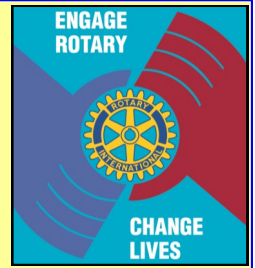

After President Janine welcomed everyone to the meeting she called upon super-sub Corporal Barry. Much to the surprise of himself, although not to many others, he was “docked 10 points” for the “incorrect order of the 4-way test”.

After the snickers died down, the President gave a rundown of a few developments:

- Denise (Kimberley South) has informed us of the nappy drive for the National Council for Persons with Disabilities. It was suggested that we all bring a pack of nappies to each Rotary meeting to support this drive
- Considering the Public Holiday on Tuesday, 24 September, it was decided that the meeting of 23 September be cancelled.
- On 30 September 2013, CCMA Commissioner Olifant will be a guest speaker. He will be discussing Marikana. Guests are welcome, please let Peter Thomas know how many guests will be coming.
- Kenton-on-Sea prize: The prize is to be used at the end of January to early February 2014. Please indicate whether you would want to go.

Sergeant Gill went about her duties, suggesting that since the meeting of 23 September is cancelled, that all duties shift on a week. Coffee Club would continue as normal.

Jennilee discussed the planned dance on 27 September from 19:00 until midnight. Tickets are R100 per person (kids under 12 get in for R50). Everyone must please assist with selling the tickets. We need approximately 150 people to attend. Peter Thomas will print the tickets.

Corlia gave feedback on the Ride for Hospice. Interact won the charity ride with a total of 206 laps. The advocates walked away with third place as well as the funky bike and team spirit awards. The bicycles will be donated to farm workers who require transportation. Ken suggests that it is made clear that the bicycles may not be sold.

Ken gave feedback regarding a visit to Rietrivier Primary School. There is no current need for a water tank. There is, however, a need for new water pipes from the current tank to the school building. The 40 year old galvanized pipes are preventing sufficient water pressure. We are looking at assisting towards the end of October.

Funding for the project can be obtained from the RI District Fund, and the remainder possibly from partnering with International people. Estimates are about R40 000 to R50 000. Hugh suggested that the Rotary Club of Kimberley do the trench digging and installation ourselves, with a qualified plumber to do the connections.

President Janine, who also visited the school, was disgusted with the current state of the ablution facilities.

Attendance Officer Ken tallied the totals and came up with 16 of 22, or 72.7% attendance for the meeting.

Liesel, full of jokes, was once again skipped at the end of the meeting due to time. Barry closed the meeting with a quote from Gandhi regarding serving the people.
