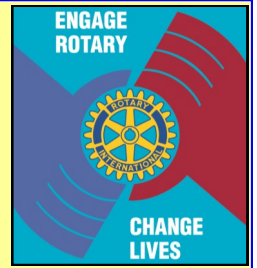

She arrived young and naïve, but departed with a greater understanding of the world. She brought her husband, Jeb, and daughter, Rheba, to Kimberley to share with them the profound effect the city, experiences and people had on her. She thanked the Websters and Joneses for hosting her all those years ago.

She is currently working with indigenous persons in Australia, often with Rotary funding.

After President Janine thanked Natasha for sharing her experiences with us, she said that often Rotarians forget the legacy we leave and the effect we have on the lives of people.

Amanda jumped at the short gap before the closure of the meeting to introduce Thlothlo (from Interact). He will be going to the USA for the YEP and thanked Natasha. "It's good to hear the experiences from someone who's been through the process firsthand" he said. Amanda gushed with pride as she informed everyone that Thlothlo's group finished second at the National debating competition.

Corporal Philip finished off his duties with a quote from Barbara Bush:

"You don't just luck into things as much as you would like to think you do. You build step by step, whether it's friendships or opportunities."
