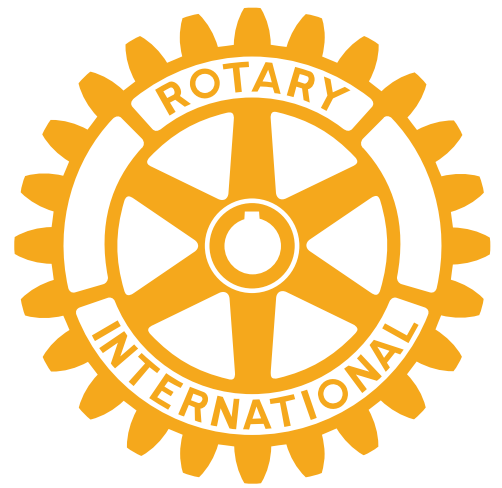

and it was noted that, if anyone was looking for lost property, they could contact Peter Thomas on 083 270 5722.

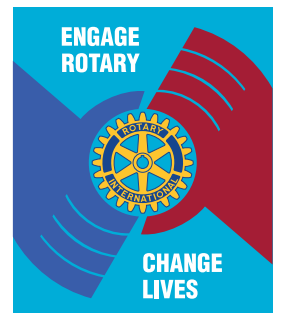
