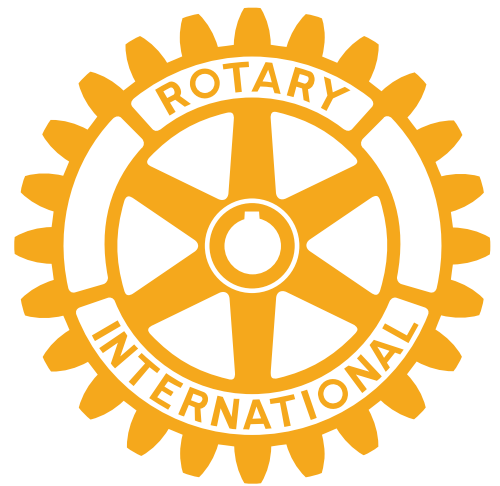

Jennilee reminded everyone that this year's Tree of Joy tickets are available. Anyone interested in taking up a ticket or two (or more) is more than welcome.

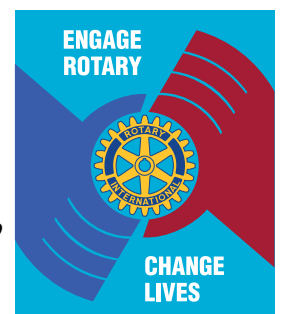
Barry announced the following: "In my Bakkie [after the Night Cycle Race], I have, looking for a home:
