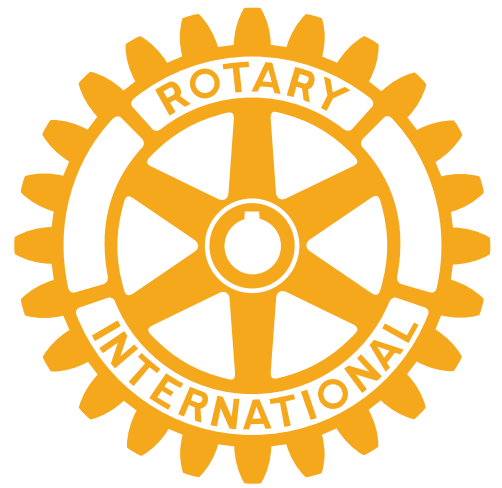

The woman prepares the plates and brings them to the table

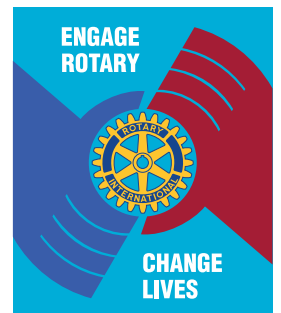
After eating, the woman clears the table and does the dishes

Everyone praises the man and thanks him for his cooking efforts

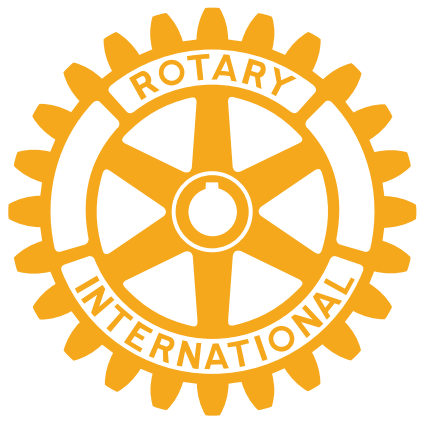
The man asks the woman how she enjoyed "her night off". And upon seeing her annoyed reaction, concludes that there is just no pleasing some women

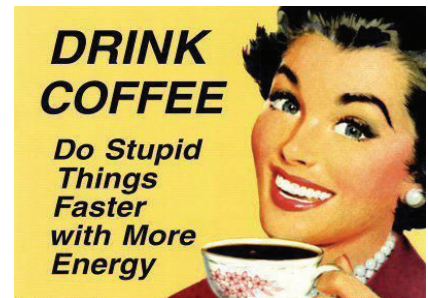
