Attendance Officer Ken, after reporting a number of

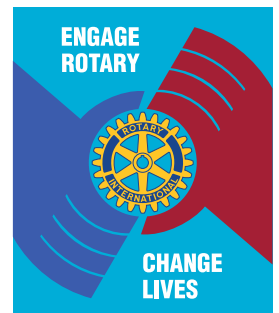
apologies, put the numbers at 16 of 22 or 72.7%.

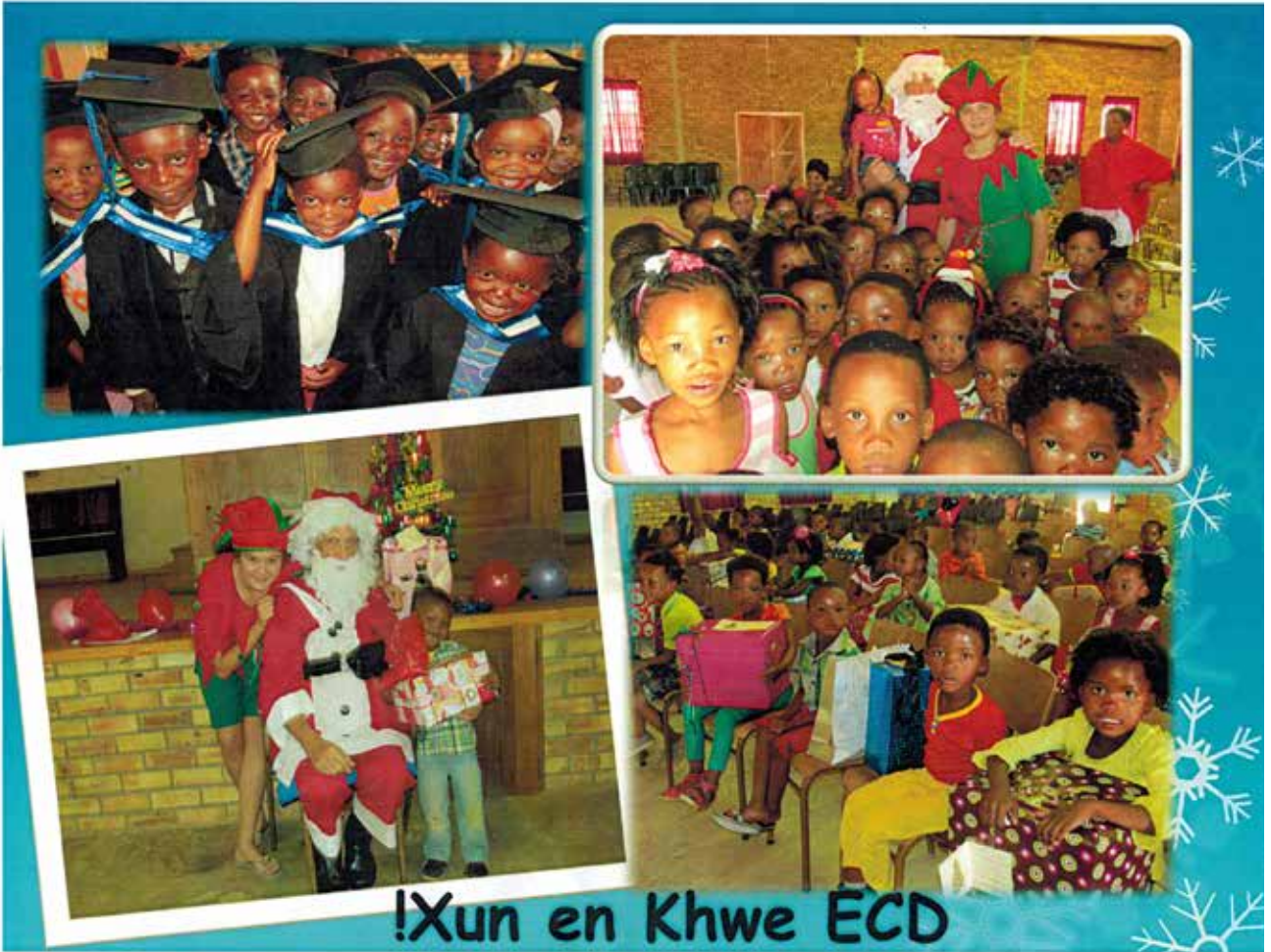
