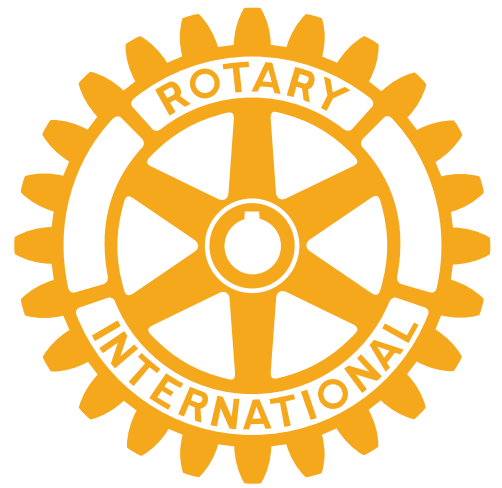

Sergeant Gill, switching to the Corporal role, told a few jokes:

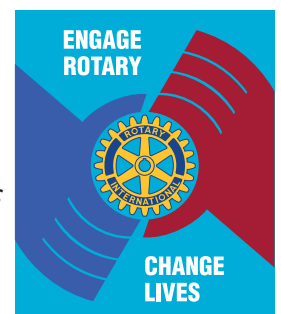
One regarding an apparent entrepreneurial, yet alcoholic, snake;

Another showed that even parrots's prayers are answered;

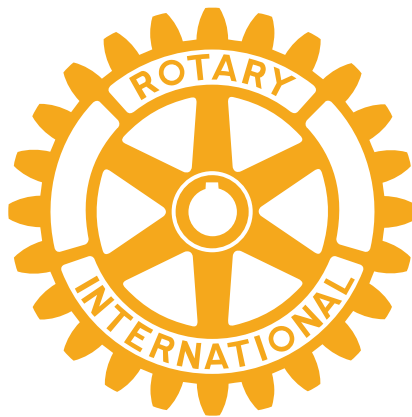
And the final one showed the dedication that some pharmaceutical firms' employees have in quality assurance.
