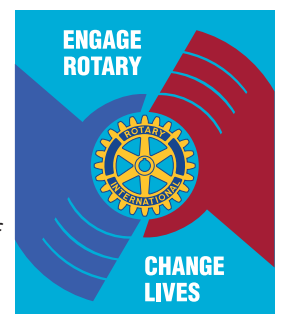
Barry reported that the CANSA Relay for Life was well attended by various schools. Amanda was there with the NCH Interact who did us all proud.

Attendance Officer Ken listed various apologies before giving the final tally as 16/22, or 72.7%.

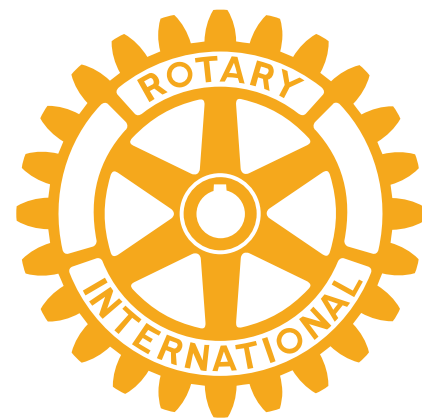

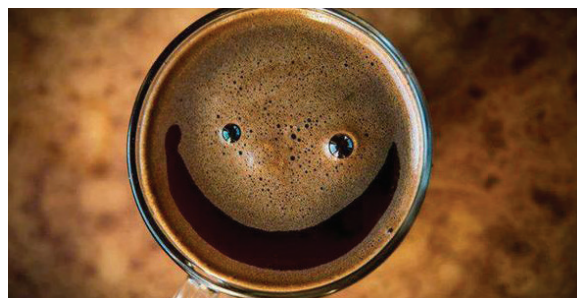
