She is a registered Independent Psychologist and is looking forward to opening her own practice.

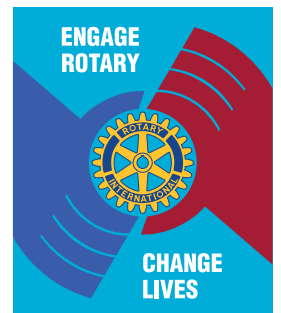
There were a few references to Barry and how Bettina could assist him while President Janine was concerned about being Psycho-analysed in conversation.

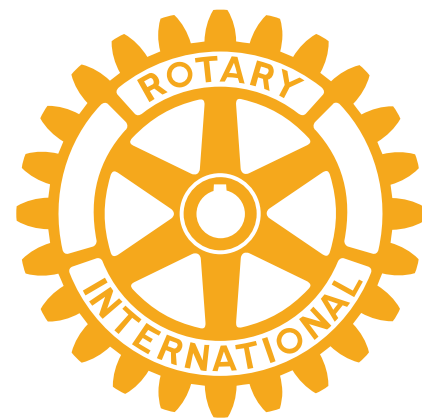
He closed off the meeting with the following tailpiece:
