And ... some Great Truths that adults have learned:

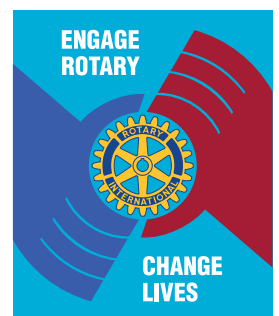
- Raising teenagers is like nailing jelly to a tree.

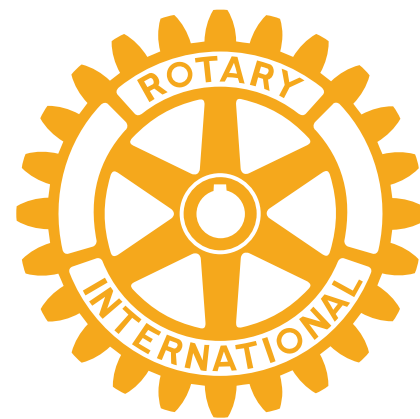
