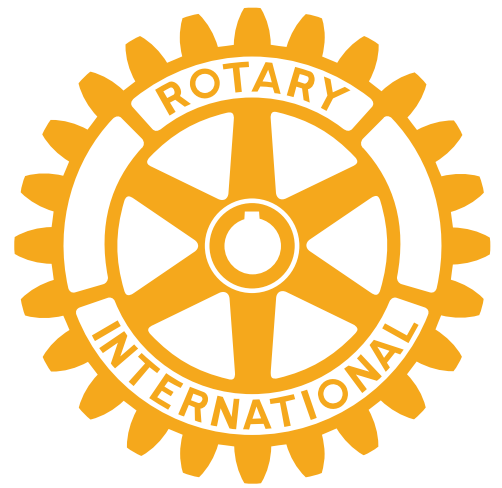

- Hulle sê die eerste jaar van trou luister die vrou na die man. Die tweede jaar luister die man na die vrou. Daarna luister die bure na hulle.

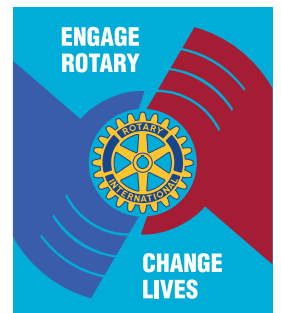
- An intelligent wife is one who makes sure that she spends so much that her husband cannot afford other women.
