treated) water.

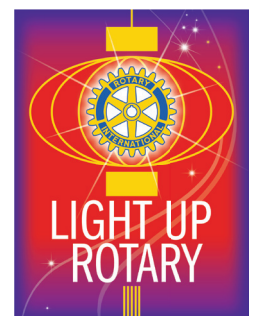
While working to provide affordable water to the poor communities, Ms Kotze also takes time to educate them on the importance of clean water. She aims to introduce a mobile clinic in the future. This mobile clinic is aimed at assisting the poorest community members, who are often unable to afford transport costs to medical facilities, with free assessments and treatment.

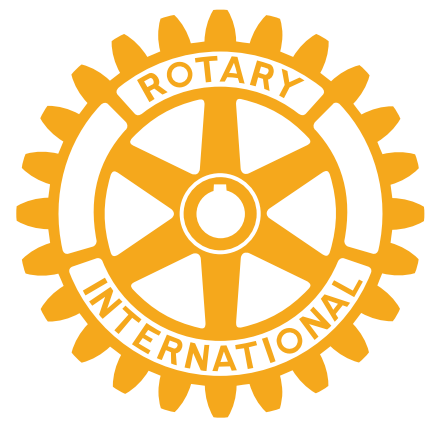
