"We make a living by what we get – but we make a life by what we give!" - Churchill.

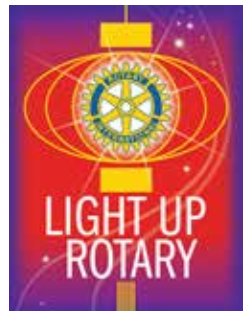

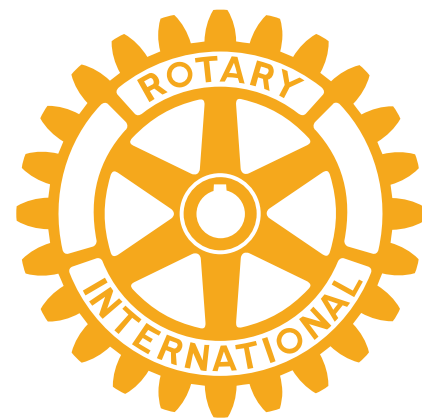
