He closed off with the following tailpiece, a quote from John C Maxwell:

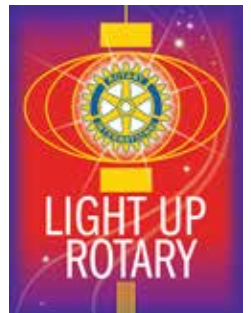
