Meeting Report: 26 January 2015 (By Peter T)

President André welcomed everyone to the luncheon, including our guests Jonathan Warner and Mary Nagle from the USA, Richard Jones (Rotary Club of Kimberley South), Jean Stemmet (guest of Jannie Jacobs) and exchange student Maddy.

After the meal, the floor was given to Jonathan Warner, who spoke about the Foetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD) project in Richmond. FASD is a continuum of various permanent birth defects caused by the mother's consumption of alcohol during pregnancy. Jonathan, a frequent visitor to South Africa since the early 80's, initiated a soup kitchen project in Richmond in 2005 which has evolved in

to the "Hope in South Africa" project, partnering with various Rotary Clubs in the Northern Cape.

FASD effects up to 15% of the people in our area and is the subject of a Rotary Global Grant to target the youth in a sports-based educational program. Mary Nagle has a long record of working among the youth and she has appealed to all Rotary Clubs to get involved in this worthwhile program. Mary and Jonathan were in Kimberley following the FASD Conference held over the weekend.

Attendance officer Ken offered apologies from Janine and Allison (leave of absence), Philip, Dwayne and Amanda - and reported the attendance at 83.3%

Sergeant Gill read the notices and celebrations and informed all that a roster would be set up for the weekly meeting report for the Rotary Griqua.

After a delicious dessert was enjoyed, Pres. André thanked everyone for their attendance and Cpl Corlia closed with the tailpiece: *"If we did all the things we were capable of in a day, we would astonish ourselves."*

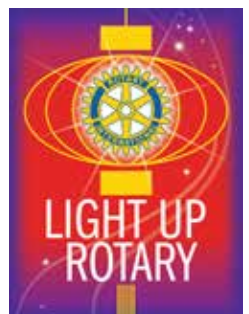

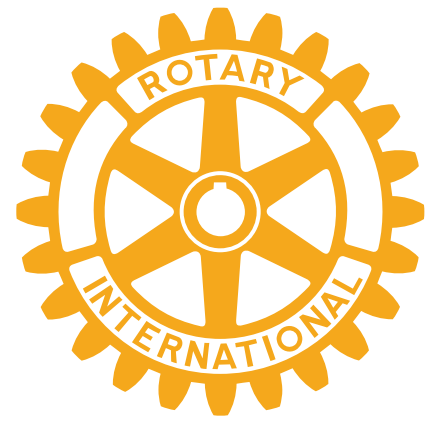
