A MAN OF COMMITMENT

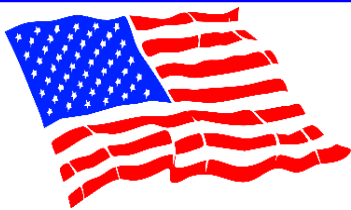
When John Germ takes office as Rotary International's President in July, it will mark his 40th year as Rotarian.

In that time, he's likely best-known for leading Rotary's \$200 Million Challenge, a fundraising effort sparked by a challenge grant from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation. Rotarians surpassed that goal in 2011, raising \$228.7 million toward polio immunisation activities. "I never questioned that we would raise the funds," he says. "Rotarians have been so generous."

In fact, raising money for polio was one of Germ's first leadership roles. He became a member of the Rotary Club of Chattanooga, Tenn. in 1976. "I wasn't involved, other than going to meetings, until 1983 when I was asked to be club secretary," he says. "Then I was asked to participate as district co-chair for the polio fundraising campaign." After that, he was hooked. "The more active I became, and the more good that I saw being done, the more I wanted to do," he says.



Germ went on to serve Rotary as vice president, director, Foundation trustee and vice chair, and RI president's aide. He and his wife, Judy, are also members of the Arch Klumph Society. Professionally, Germ continues to consult for Campbell & Associates, a Chattanooga engineering firm he started working for in 1965 and eventually served as chairman and CEO.

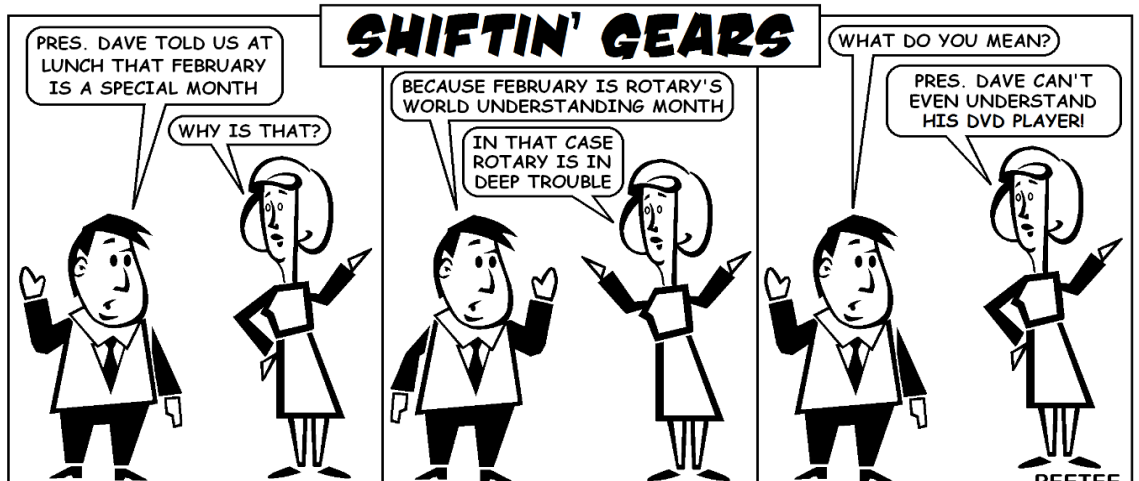
