She closed off with the following tailpiece:

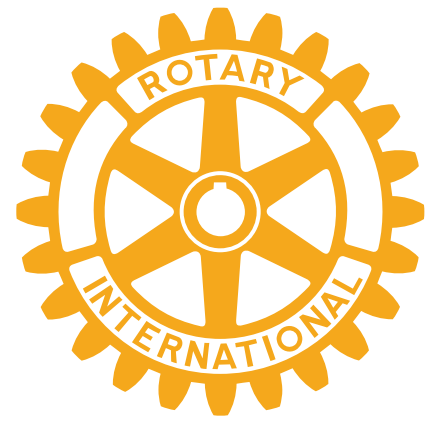
