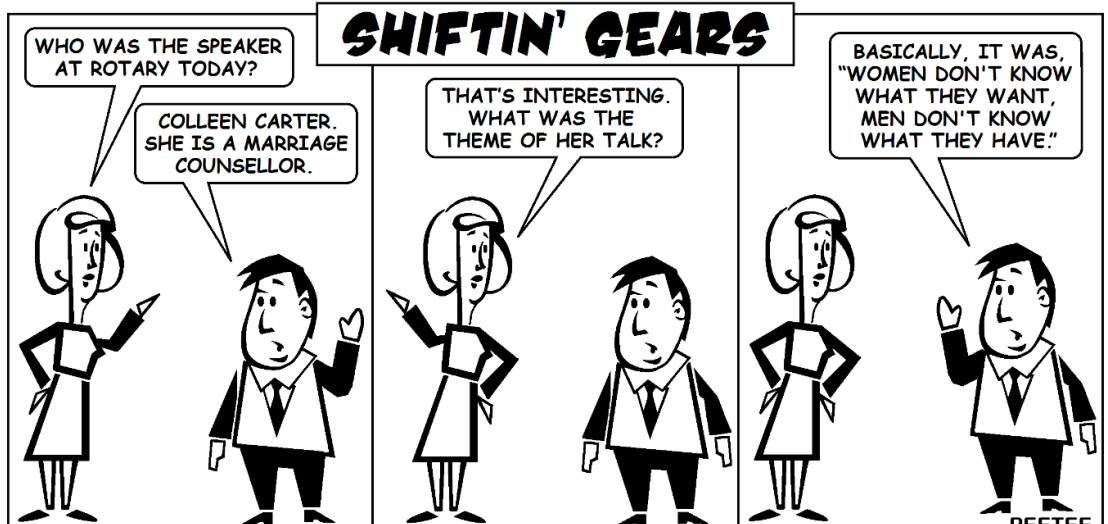
Professional Cyclist and Cancer Survivor, Lance Armstrong [*Lance Gunderson*] celebrates his 46th birthday today.
