Doing the right thing is more important than doing the thing right.

If you want something new, you have to stop doing something old.

WHO WAS PETER DRUCKER?

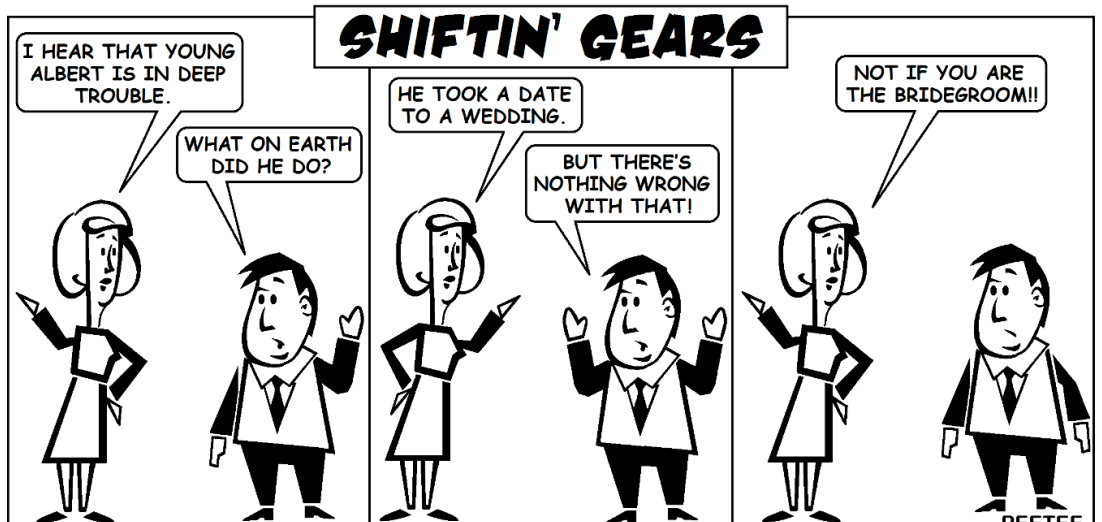
Peter Ferdinand Drucker (19 Nov. 1909 – 11 Nov. 2005) was an Austrian-born American management consultant, educator, and author, whose writings contributed to the philosophical and practical foundations of the modern business corporation. He was also a leader in the development of management education and has been described as "the founder of modern management".

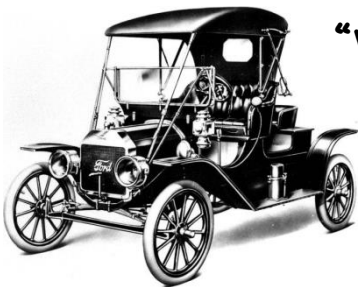
