MAY IS YOUTH SERVICE MONTH

Rotarians have always taken a sincere interest in helping to prepare the next generation – with programs and projects that help with health and education and lead the way to world peace and understanding.

Young people are the future of our organization if we choose for Rotary to survive and thrive beyond our lifetime. Through Rotary's youth programs, we can introduce the next generation to the ideals of "Service Above Self".

Rotary focuses on the youth with the following programs:

<u>Interact</u> - Interact is a Rotary sponsored club for ages 12 to 18, typically at a high school. Interactors involve themselves with local community projects and fundraising for charities. They often "adopt" and support a nearby school in a less affluent suburb.

<u>Earlyact</u> – Earlyact functions similarly to Interact, but at primary school level.

Rotaract – is a Rotary sponsored club for ages 18 to 30. Rotaractors are involved in community and international service projects, as well as professional development and leadership training, and are good partners in service with their sponsoring Rotary clubs.

Rotary Long-Term Youth Exchange – This is the leading international student exchange program in the world, sending students out to foreign countries each year and hosting students from around the globe to spend a year of high school in foreign communities.

Rotary Short-Term Youth Exchange – This is an international student exchange program, sending students out to foreign countries for a six to eight week exchange, and hosting students from around the globe for a similar period. Attending school overseas is optional.

RYLA – Rotary Youth Leadership Awards is a premium weekend leadership camp for high school students. Every club is encouraged to send at least one student from their local community to benefit from the "life-changing experience" offered at RYLA.

You can tell that there is a wide range of programs and projects included under the Youth Service umbrella. Virtually every club in our District in involved in one or more of these youth programs, for the benefit of their community.
