On behalf of the residents and management committee of Sally Aucamp Home for the Physically Disabled we wish to thank Rotary Kimberley for the most generous donation of R1000 for which we are overwhelmed.

Sally Aucamp is the only home in the Northern Cape for physically disabled adults of all races. We currently have 14 residents with most of our residents having no hope of ever recovering. Few have families who can assist them financially, so they are dependent on the department of welfare for disability pensions and government subsidies, and the home is the only home they have.

Due to the home relying on donations to make ends meet funds are always tight and the voluntary committee work hard to raising the extra finances we need each month to cover the deficit on our budget. With the Covid-19 pandemic our country is facing we never received any food donations during this time, so your donation will assist tremendously towards our food costs for which we are extremely grateful.

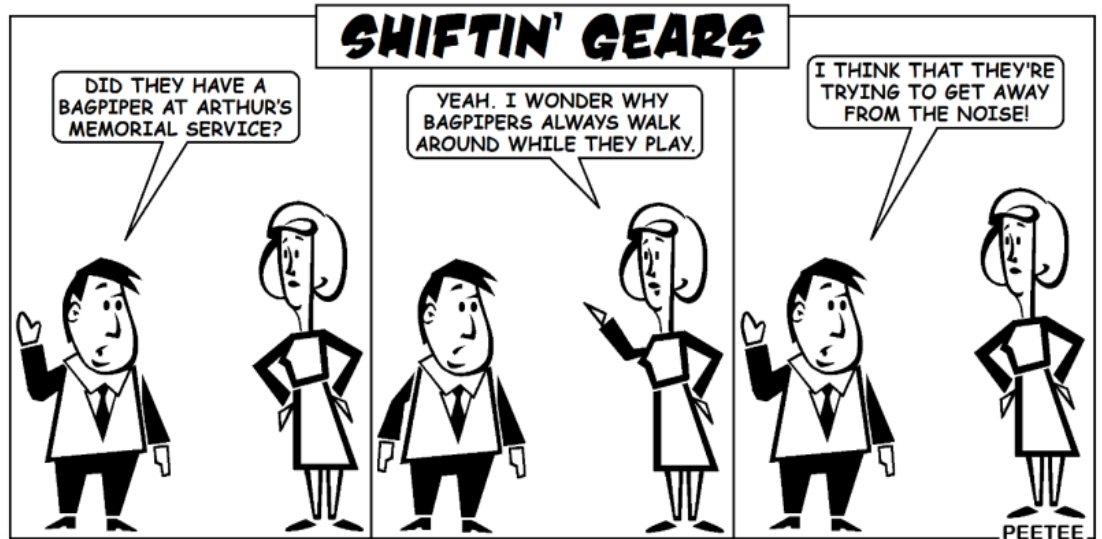
